

S2C CAMPING ARRANGEMENTS 2024 S2C - CAMPING INFORMATION v2

OPTION 1 - S2C CAMPING AREA

Area is reserved for S2C - campfires provided by campsite allowed - dogs permitted

- Your pitch is pre-arranged do not call to book!
- S2C camping pitches have been pre-arranged in an area allocated for the event.
- CASH ONLY! The campsite warden will visit to check you in and tag your accommodation.

S2C Pitch Fees (tent/camper/caravan)

- £20 per <u>occupied</u> pitch (i.e. staying overnight)
- £10 per <u>unoccupied</u> pitch (i.e. set up only not sleeping overnight)
- On Friday, access to set up in the S2C camping area is permitted for those wishing to set up in advance. Fee applies whether the pitch is occupied or not.

Other Fees

- £5 per dog (must be kept on leads and cleaned up after)
- £22 'campfire bundle' (2x bags of logs, 1x fire pit, 2x kindling & firelighters, bucket & grill
 - o Only campfires provided by the campsite are permitted until 11pm

OPTION 2 - MAIN CAMPSITE

- Make sure to mention S2C during booking process.

Access is permitted for those wishing to set up in advance for convenience (pitch fee applies whether you are staying there or not). Please adhere to the on-site signage and set up in the top field (you pass alongside it when driving down the campsite access road).

SATURDAY 14 SEPTEMBER 2024

A cuppa and bun awaits all paddlers upon arrival. Please let us know in advance about any food allergies or dietary requirements so can do our best to accommodate you.
